## ***Research interests***

### **Research interests and scientific works**

They concern the analysis and study of topics related to economic geography in local background, at the beginning with particular attention to Liguria and Sardinia (thermal baths, port activities, regional economics systems). Themes linked to environment and to organization of the territory (water policy, prevention of forest fires) are a second strand of study. Later I dealt with the issues concerning tourism and related policies for development. Particular attention it has been given to the theme of renovation and functionalism of the waterfront and the pleasure boating. More recently, the analysis and the scientific production have included themes linked to the political geography and geopolitics with particular regard to the Mediterranean areas, in line with the placement within the Department of Political Sciences.
