Research interests

The main topics of my researches concern

- identification and study of biodeteriogenic microfungi of dehydrated edible macrofungi;
- study of fungal biodeteriogens on paper (foxing) and interior walls; definition of prophylaxis protocols;
- identification of opportunistic fungi agents of superficial mycosis with particular reference to onychomycosis;

- study of fungal communities present in contaminated sites (mines, landfills) and isolation of fungal strains for mycoremediation protocols;
- isolation of native mycelia for the cultivation of saprotrophic mushrooms and / or nutraceuticals;
- development of protocols for the cultivation of saprotrophic mushrooms and / or nutraceuticals;
- floristic, mycological and ecological studies on hypogeus and epigeal macrofungi in different phytocoenoses of Liguria (beech, holm oak, pinewood). Data processing using numerical ecology techniques;
- synergies between GIS technologies and eco-mycology studies for the assessment of territorial potential or environmental damage;
- silvicultural management for macrofungi production.
