I belong to the editorial boards of «Hasse-Werkausgabe» (Carus), of the journals «Comunicazioni sociali» (Vita & pensiero) and «Hasse-Studien» (Carus), and the series «Musica contemporanea» (Mimesis) and n«Musica teatrale del Settecento Italiano – I drammi di N. Jommelli» (ETS).
Since 2005 I am editor of the "Edizioni Suvini Zerboni News".
Up to June 2022

- I published 6 books (2004, 2007, 2010, 2013, 2017, 2022): one of them (Con moltissima passione. Ritratto di Giuseppe Verdi) reached a third edition; a second one (Il racconto della musica europea. Da Bach a Debussy) a second edition; a third one (Johann Sebastian Bach. Le cantate) was given the Carlo Maria Martini International Award 2013; a fourth (Johann Adolf Hasse) has been translated into German (2016) in a revised, updated version and very positively reviewed in the 'Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung'.
- I edited, alone or with colleagues, one critical edition of a score, one critical edition of a text, and five volumes
- I published ca. 35 articles in scientific journals
- I published ca. 75 essays in volumes or proceedings
- I published more than 200 articles in encyclopedias and dictionaries
- I edited 5 opera librettos
- I published more than 125 texts in Teatro alla Scala program notes
- I published ca. 200 texts in program notes of several opera houses and concert seasons, and for 7 complete concert seasons in Italy and Europe
- I published notes for more than 60 CDs
- I translated 6 essays
- I published more than 80 reviews of books, shows and CDs
