The research work seeks to open up an overview on some Milanese experiences involving the well-known fashion designer Elio Fiorucci, chosen as a paradigmatic example to investigate some specific aspects connected to creativity and the studies around fashion. The first chapter reconstructs some pivotal events of the decade, such as the 16th Milan Triennale, with its exhibition *Notes and Images for a Fashion Map*, and the editorial experiment of "Domus Moda", commissioned by Alessandro Mendini. The second chapter is dedicated to Fiorucci's graphics, the main medium for creating the brand image. Fiorucci graphics and their stylistic features are analysed starting from an intuition of Giovanni Anceschi and some notes by David Foster Wallace, trying to recontextualise them within the complex panorama of visual culture between the 1970s and 1980s. The last chapter is dedicated to the artistic performances hosted in Fiorucci's Milanese stores, spaces in which fashion could coexist with an expanded artistic dimension. The examination of the performances by the Nova Musicha group, Alessandro Mendini and Keith Haring has meant a reconsideration of the identities of the places, but also a rediscovery of some decisive moments for the art scene in Milan.

The work is enriched by the consultation of archive material and documents, never published before for the major part, made available by Fiorucci's heirs and former collaborators .

The thesis analyses the complex history of the journey of Gian Lorenzo Bernini (1598-1680) in France and the creation of the portrait of Luis XIV. It tries to explain why the permanence of Bernini at Luis XIV court is strongly linked to the turbulent political situation of the 1660s and to the difficult relationship between Paris and Rome. Basing on sources of the period, the thesis explores Bernini's way of working, from the initial idea to the finished marble. It also tries to explain all the symbolic implications concealed into the portrait, taking into considerations especially the never realized globe-shaped base.

This thesis was enhanced by a period of research in Paris, where the candidate could see the original work and consult the Bernini dossier at Palace of Versailles Library.
