## Research interests

Various topics of general and special criminal law: criminal protection of the consumer, a topic on which my first monograph, titled 'The criminal protection of consumers health' (2006, Giappichelli) was focused; criminal protection of the environment, to which I dedicated some papers published in nationally relevant law reviews of Class A, as well as within 'Criminal Law Handbook. Complementary laws', by ANTOLISEI (13th ed. 2014, 14th ed. 2018, 15th ed. 2022, Giuffrè), and within the Treaty directed by PALAZZO and PALIERO, edited by PELISSERO Crimes against the environment and the territory (1st ed. 2013, 2nd ed. 2019, Giappichelli); criminal protection against commercial fraud and counterfeiting of trademarks and other distinctive signs, to which I dedicated some papers published in nationally relevant law reviews of Class A; criminal protection of the worker, dealt with in collective books; criminal liability in the health sector, dealt with both in papers published in nationally relevant journals, and in the second monograph titled 'Models of attribution of liability to healthcare bodies for patient's adverse event in Italy and England' (2020, Giappichelli); criminal protection of the family, a topic dealt within 'Criminal Law Handbook. The Special Part', by ANTOLISEI (16th ed. 2016, 17th ed. 2022, Giuffrè), as well as in papers published in nationally relevant law reviews of Class A; food fraud, to which I dedicated papers published in nationally relevant law reviews of Class A, as well as the comment on law n. 283/1962 in the 'Commentary on Complementary Criminal Acts', directed by PALAZZO and PALIERO and edited by GARGANI (2nd edition 2007, Cedam), and in the 'Theoretical-practical treatise Punitive offences in agri-food matters', edited by GARGANI A. (2021 Giappichelli ).

Another topic is the comparison between Italian, English, Spanish criminal law: some papers about criminal protection of environment in England, published in nationally relevant law reviews of Class A, and 'Security Penalties in Spanish Criminal law' into '10 Years of REMS', edited by PELISSERO, SCOMPARIN, TORRENTE (2022, ESI).
