Comparative study on urban conviviality created by Social Streets in metropolitan contexts of Milan, Bologna and Rome. New trends of civic participation in urban neighbourhoods, structural urban analysis, practices and values of belonging among neighbourhoods. A study on Social Streets through research on the three cities in which the phenomenon is most widespread: Milan (72), Bologna (65) and Rome (33), through interviews with the founders of the Social Streets, online survey to the Streeters (772 in Milan, 518 in Bologna, 140 in Rome), ethnographies and netnographies. The aim of this research is to understand the socio-economic profile of the Streeters and the reasons behind the creation of neighbourhood ties. In addition, it has been deepened what Social Streets can tell us about these three cities and what contribution they can make to the development and vitality of the city.
