In 1989 he graduated in Medicine and Surgery and in 1993 he obtained the specialization in Psychiatry, both at the University of Genoa. Later he graduated in Clinical Criminology with a medical-psychological and psychiatric-forensic focus in 1996 at the University of Genoa, too. In 1997 he got a refinement in Bioethics at the University of Milan, S. Raffaele Institute.

From 1991 to 1998 he worked as psychiatrist at the Department of Mental Health in Savona, after that he worked in Genoa, where he is still working. During his work in Genoa, he particularly focused his psychiatric involvement in the field of rehabilitation, in fact he directed from 1999 to 2009 a Day Centre for Psychiatric rehabilitation.

In July 2009 he became, and still is, Director of the Mental Health Service of the Middle West District of the Mental Health and Addictions Department of the Health Public Agency n. 3 (ASL 3) of Liguria. In 2013 he founded and still directs the Psychiatric Service of Care and Rehabilitation in the Antero Micone General Hospital in Genoa.

From 2002 he is collaborating with the University of Genoa by giving lessons to Medical Doctors, Educators, Psychosocial Rehabilitation Technicians and Social Health Workers students. He is also collaborating with other Mental Health Public Departments and other Agencies in the training of Health Workers. He took part in the Summer School and in the Winter School of the University of Genoa in 2024 and 2025.

He was President of the Liguria section of the Italian Society of Psychiatry between 2000 and 2005 and then he took part for many years in its National Directory Board. He took also part as a Consultant to the Scientific Committee of the Exhibition "*Malati, manicomì e psichiatri in Italia. Dal ventennio fascista alla seconda guerra mondiale*". This section was added to the Italian editions of the exhibition "*Schedati, perseguitati, sterminati. Malati psichici e disabili durante il nazionalsocialismo*". This exhibition was presented in various Italian cities. He is effective fellow of the Accademia Ligure di Scienze e Lettere (Academy of Science and Letters of Liguria) and is member of the Directory Board of the Italian Society of Psychiatry and Philosophy and of the Italian Society for the History of Psychiatry.

He took part in more than 500 scientific events, in 30 of them as a member of the Organizing or Scientific Committee, in 37 as a Chairman or a Discussant, in more than 170 as a Speaker in a Congress and in more than 100 as a Speaker in conferences, round tables and other minor events.
