

PROFILE IN BRIEF

Gianluca Serafini was born in Avezzano (L'Aquila), Italy, in 1978 from Italian parents. He took his degree in Medicine and Surgery at Sapienza University of Rome, later becoming psychiatrist. In 2012, he obtained his Ph.D. in Psychiatry: Early Interventions in Psychosis. He was Assistant Professor of Psychiatry from 2014 to 2018, from 2018 to 2022 Associate Professor, and from December 2022 Full Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Genoa, Section of Psychiatry, IRCCS Ospedale Policlinico San Martino.

From over ten years he worked as clinician and researcher at Sant'Andrea Hospital in Rome where, from 2007, he is an active member of the Center for suicide research and prevention. His major research interests include: psychopathology and neurobiology of major affective disorders and suicidal behaviour, neuropsychopharmacology, neuroplasticity, and early interventions in psychiatry.

He has been included from 2010 to 2015 in "Marquis Who's Who in the World and he is fellow of several scientific Societies (New York Academy of Sciences, International Society for Affective Disorders, International Association for Suicide Prevention, World Suicidology Net, Sociedad Española De Patología Dual, European Psychiatric Association (Secretary of the Neuroimaging section), Società Italiana di Psichiatria, Associazione Italiana Lotta allo Stigma).

He is an active researcher being the author of more than 360 publications in peer-reviewed scientific Journals. From 2008 he was speaker in more than 500 national and international conferences; he was Editor-in-Chief of Journal of Life Medicine while he is actually Editor-in-Chief of Behavioral Sciences (MDPI) and Journal of Medical Disorders (HOAJ). He was Associate Editor of Neuroscience Research Letters and he is currently Associate Editor of BMC Psychiatry, Frontiers in Psychiatry, Current Pharmacogenomics & Personalized Medicine, and Advances in Medical Informatics. He actually serves as reviewer for more than 300 peer-reviewed international Journals, and he is Editorial/Advisory Board member of more than 60 peer-reviewed international Journals.
