I acquired the ability to manage classroom moments in my university teaching career by taking courses for clinical tutors, striving to abandon the "traditional" lecture style where the instructor speaks without engaging the students. This is done with the aim of maintaining attention and encouraging students to participate and be active participants. I believe it is important to frequently check for understanding of the topics covered, also using "everyday life" problems as examples; experience has taught me that concepts that are obvious to the instructor may not be so obvious to the students. I believe, based on my studies and experience, that it pays to establish a relationship based not on authority but rather on the instructor's authority and mutual respect.

In my work, it is essential to be available to the students and collaborate with colleagues in order to create a working group that maximizes the abilities and predisposition of each individual to fill the role that best suits their specific skills and characteristics. Try to avoid direct confrontations as much as possible and create a tension-free work environment. Experience has taught me that when tensions and organizational shortcomings are minimized, staff availability and involvement are significantly greater.
