# Teaching activity

This workshop allowed students of the three-year Degree Course to obtain up to 2 credits (other credits) and to students of the two-year Master's Degree program to obtain up to 3 credits (other credits);

in 2012-13 and 2013-14 I was assigned the task of teaching the discipline 'Historiography and Medieval and Humanistic Latin literature' (9 CFU) at the Master of Science in Historical Sciences, Archives and Libraries, University of Genoa;

in the academic year 2014-15 I was given the task of teaching the discipline: 'Medieval and Humanistic Latin Culture' (9 CFU) at the Degree Course in History, University of Genoa;

in 2015-16; 2016-17; 2017-18 I covered the teachings of 'Medieval and Humanistic Latin Culture' (9 CFU) at the Degree Course in History, University of Genoa and 'Medieval and Humanistic Historiography and Latin Literature' (9 CFU) at the Masters Degree in Historical Sciences, University of Genoa. in 2018-2019 I shall keep the teachings of 'Medieval and Humanistic Latin

Literature' (9 CFU) at the Degree Course in History, University of Genoa and 'Literature, historiography and forms of theater in the Middle Ages and Latin Humanism' (9 CFU) at the Master of Science in Historical Sciences, University of Genoa.

## Research interests

My researches cover various fields of Medieval and Humanistic Latin Literature and Philology. I published essays and critical editions concerning medieval commentaries on the classics (Nicola Trevet, Commentary on the Phaedra of Seneca [critical edition]; Giovanni Segarelli); the travel accounts of Medieval and Humanistic travellers (Giovanni di Pian del Carpine, Guglielmo di Rubruck, Olao Magno); the Elegia of Arrigo da Settimello [critical edition]; the XVth century Latin historiography (Antonio Gallo, Commentarius de Genuensium maritima classe [critical edition]: Biondo Flavio, Letter to Pietro Campofregoso [critical edition]; Ursone da Sestri, Historia de victoria quam Genuenses ex Friderico retulerunt a. MCCXLII [critical edition, in press]). Besides she studied Medieval and Humanistic Latin authors and literary themes ("Fortleben" of the History Apollonii regis Tyri, Antonio Cornazzano, Enea Silvio Piccolomini, Poggio Bracciolini). I also dealt with theatrical literature: in this field I published critical editions with Italian translation and commentary of the humanistic comedies Paedia (written by an anonymous author) and Tito Livio Frulovisi's Peregrinatio, Emporia and Symmachus.
