I also studied macroeconomic models with oligopolistic enterprises, with processes of entry / exit of new firms, in order to deepen the economic cycle and the effects on it of social mobility. I am also interested in health economics, the effect of public spending and investment policies on the health of the population. I also work on the effect of technological progresses, especially the development of artificial intelligence, on the labor market, on the distribution of income and on the electoral cycle. Finally, I deal with developing forecast macroeconomic models of regional GDP.
